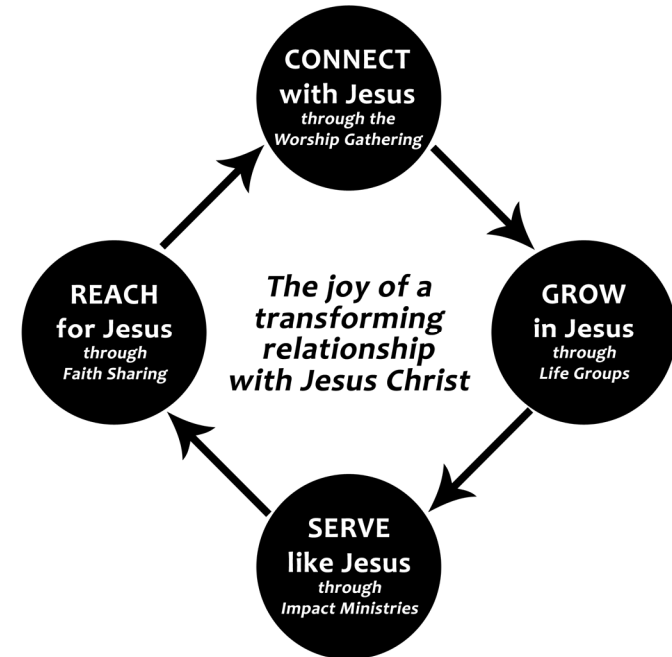
OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD
